Mr. Helminski retired from the U.S. Secret Service in late 2015 as Deputy Assistant Director serving in the Office of Investigations, overseeing all domestic Secret Service field offices and resident offices. Directing all criminal investigations, presidential, vice presidential, and dignitary protective responsibilities, Electronic Crimes Task Forces, and Financial Crime Task Forces investigating cyber-crime and the protection of the nation's financial infrastructure.

Mr. Helminski has been a supervisor on both the Presidential and Vice-Presidential protective details and has served as the Special Agent in Charge of multiple offices throughout his 27-year career. Mr. Helminski progressed to the highest level of federal government executive management by entering the ranks of the Senior Executive Service (SES) and appointed to the U.S. Secret Service Director's Staff as Deputy Assistant Director & Chief Human Capital Officer overseeing the Human Capital Division and provided overall management of all Secret Service human resources planning, policy and program development, employee benefits and payroll, and professional position classifications.
