Ms. Hurley was the first-ever female Special Agent in Charge (SAIC) at the Pentagon Force Protection Agency (PFPA) and first female Special Agent in Charge of the PFPA Joint Terrorism Task Force (JTTF) Division. Ms. Hurley also represented the Pentagon at the FBI National Joint Terrorism Task Force (NJTTF) in Washington, DC.

Ms. Hurley has led Executive Protection (EP) missions for the Department of Defense; for the Under Secretaries of Defense, visiting foreign Ministers of Defense (MOD), and visiting Chairman's of Defense (CHOD). She has led CONUS & OCONUS, EP missions as a Detail Leader, Site Agent, and Advance Team Leader to include war zones for the Under Secretaries of Defense for Policy and Intelligence.

During her tenure Ms. Hurley also helped create the first Cabinet Level Executive Protection Team for the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA).

Ms. Hurley earned a Bachelor of Science Degree from Norwich University Military College of Vermont Corps of Cadets and she also earned her Master's Degree from Johns Hopkins in Executive Police Leadership.
